- Jason and Don completed a site visit on October 21st. Jason explained that the four foot ditch was dug from a natural spring across Mr. Noel's property and another property to Mr. Gannerelli's property. The spring is not attached to Swamp Creek and is not a flowing body of water, therefore not under the 310 jurisdiction. Mr. Noel will be in contact with the Army Corp of Engineers, if they deem this a flowing body of water ESCD will revisit the site to make the appropriate action.
- Montana Association of Conservation District (MACD) Annual Convention
 - The annual MACD Convention will be held via Zoom November 18th and 19th. At least one Supervisor is needed to attend to vote on the Resolutions being discussed. A motion was made by Ron appointing John as the voting Supervisor, 2nd by Marvin; motion carried.

Natural Resources Conservation Services (NRCS) Report, Dillon Martini via email

- November 17th is the deadline for EQIP and CSP applications. There are currently two TIPs being funded in Sanders County; 1) cover crop and 2) Aspen Regeneration on the reservation.

Fish Wildlife Parks (FWP) Report, Jason Blakney

- General rifle season opened Saturday, October 24. The hunter check station on the west side of Thompson Falls will be a CWD check station this fall and will be open from 11 am-dusk on the weekends and as well as on Mondays throughout. Hunter can drop off their samples or have them collected by staff at the check station. For question call (406) 752-5501 or visit fwp.mt.gov/cwd.
- MFWP collected and released about 290 Westslope Cutthroat Trout into several miles of excellent tributary habitat above a waterfall in Bear Creek in the Thompson River drainage in late September. Donor streams were first tested for fish pathogens, aquatic invasive species and all translocated fish were genetically tested prior to release. USFS staff assisted with packing the fish into their new home. This effort is part of a larger 5-year project to conserve local genetic stocks as many are in danger of being lost to hybridization or being replaced/displaced by non-native trout species.
